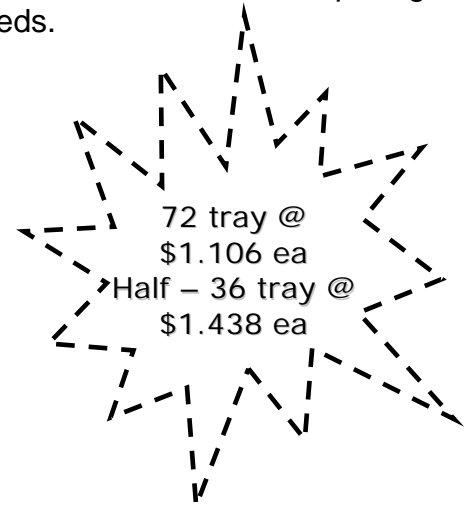


HIGH Q GREENHOUSES INFORMATION SHEET

HIBISCUS

These impressive, stately plants produce many large, eye-catching flowers in a beautiful, deep burgundy color. Great in containers or garden beds.



Luna™ Series Red

Flowering Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Summer
Habit	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Large, bushy, well-branched plants with 18cm/7" gorgeous flowers• Heat loving and drought tolerant once established• 60-90cm/2' high and 60cm/2' wide
Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Light – Full sun. Luna Hibiscus requires a minimum of 12 hours of day length to flower. A day length of 14 hours or longer will result in faster flowering• Soil – Peat-based medium with pH 6 – 6.5• Water – Keep moist to wet. Consistent soil moisture is important – drought tolerant once established in the garden• Fertilizer – Feed plants at every watering with 200-250 ppm N• Temperature – 18-21°C night, 21-30°C day. Cooler temperatures will prolong crop time• Growth Rate – 10-13 weeks to flowering after transplanting from plugs• Regulators – Apply twice at two weeks interval after transplanting• Pests & Diseases – Thrips, aphids, spider mites• Pinching – None required
Application	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Grower: Suitable for large pots, 1 plant per 6" pots, up to 3 plants per 1 gallon pots• Consumer: Great in containers or flower beds• Makes a wonderful, short, flowering hedge
